## Gamma Upsilon Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated and Ivy Foundation of Hampton, Inc. High School Book Scholarship Criteria

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Applicants must be a Senior graduating this year from a Hampton City Public School (Bethel, Hampton, Kecoughtan, or Phoebus High School).
- Applicants must be enrolling in a four (4) year college or university for the 2022-2023 school year.
- Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.

#### Requirements

- 1. A completed Scholarship Application. The application must be typed (12 inch) format.
- 2. An official (sealed) high school transcript...
- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendation from your school counselor and/or from your teachers. Typed in 12 inch font.
- 4. An essay, minimum three hundred (300) words and a maximum of six hundred (600) words, double-spaced, (Times New Roman) twelve (12) inch font.
- 5. The essay must be typewritten and must include your name and the title of your topic in the right hand upper corner of your submission.
- 6. Documented proof of participation within your high school and/or volunteer /community/ church activities.
- 7. Include a formal <u>"headshot"</u> photograph that focuses upon your face. Please note the photograph release form is included within this application and should be completed and signed with you and your parent and/or guardians' official signature.
- 8. Applicants for this scholarship may be asked to participate in an interview process planned by the Scholarship Committee.

#### **Essay Topics**

All applicants must submit an essay which addresses one (1) of the four (4) topics below:

- A. **STEM** Why is a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) education important? What are ways you experience STEM in your everyday life?
- B. **Black World History** Discuss the historical purpose of "Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) in America." Why were these schools initially created? Why are these schools still important today? Discuss four (4) specific myths about HBCUs that exist today. Define the "Missouri Effect" and the impact this effect has had upon HBCUs since the year 2016.
- C. **Technological Social Justice** On-line internet searches represents' algorithmic misconception and misrepresentation of a variety of people and ideas. Documented research studies suggest "Google" algorithms discriminate against women and people of color. Explain on-line bias against teenage/young adult Black women, how this behavior impacts these young women and give specific suggestions to disrupt the harmful societal interpretation.
- D. Conflict and Resolution- Have you ever been treated unfairly because of your race, your religion, the way you look, or just because you are "different"? Unfortunately, many of us have. Give an explanation about a specific time you were treated unfairly. How did you react? How did it make you feel? How was the situation resolved?

#### Award Amount for Book Scholarship

One (1) time award of six hundred-fifty dollars (\$650.00)
